NB: Those invited as reviewers via a mail will have to use option 3. to reset their password before login process.




Figure 4: Login page




Figure 5: Reset Password tab





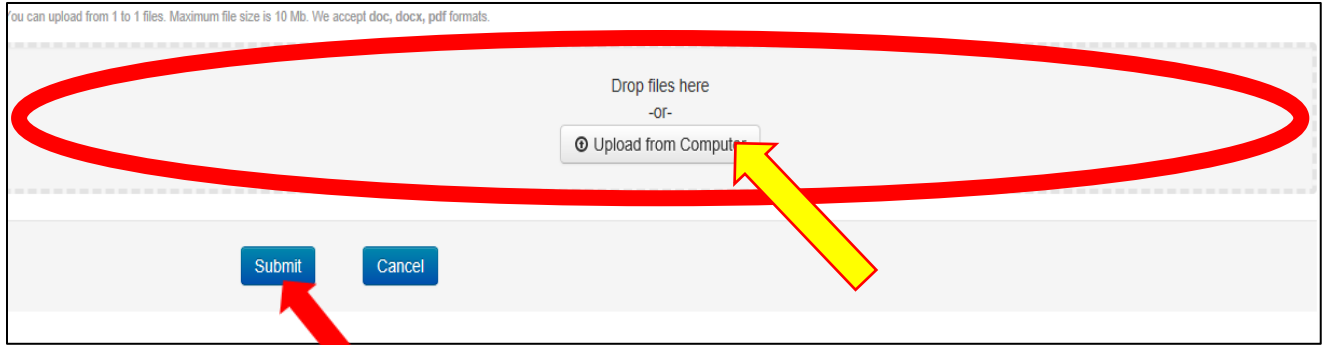


Figure 16: Uploading the paper
